CHELSEA NEIGHBORHOOD NEWS

CHELSEA VETERAN'S DAY CEREMONY ON MON., NOV. 11 at 10 AM

Frank Meade of our building is once again inviting us all—especially veterans and their families—to this annual marking of Veteran's Day. It's a 15-minute ceremony at Ninth Avenue & 27th St. at the monument of the doughboy, dedicated to all the soldiers and sailors of Chelsea in World War I. It brings together community members, those from the City's uniformed services, and our elected officials to honor the service of veterans. Join us.

RENT-CONTROLLED TENANTS' VICTORY

To be rent-controlled (and not to rent stabilized), a lease must date before 1975. There are only about 20 rent-controlled tenants here at London Terrace —while about half of us are under the broader rent-stabilization laws. Rent increases for these older tenants in recent decades have been larger than those imposed on rent-stabilized tenants (7.5% each year plus fuel pass-along charges). But our landlord failed to file the paperwork properly for their annual rent increase last year and the DHCR ruled that increases can't be imposed—a break after years of onerous increases.

New rent laws just passed by the New York State legislature—and supported by the LTAA—mean future increases for rent-controlled tenants will be more modest. All stabilized tenants gained more protections as well! The LTAA, Council Speaker Johnson's office, and tenants such as Frank Meade aided on behalf of the tenants. The landlord can appeal the ruling of the DHCR to the courts. But for now, victory.

CALLE DAO DENIED SIDEWALK CAFÉ

Calle Dao restaurant at 465 W. 23rd got its liquor license approval from the Community Board by pledging *not* to apply for a sidewalk cafe unless we, the LTAA and the Towers, supported one. And we do not support it—though we know some in the building disagree. Calle Dao applied anyway—in defiance of stipulations they agreed to—and the City Council denied the permit. Calle Dao has been in court working to get the Council's decision overturned. Erik Bottcher, Corey Johnson's chief of staff, reported that “the judge rejected Calle Dao's request to lift the stay, so the sidewalk cafe still cannot operate. Our appeal papers are due in early November and we are actively working on them with the Law Dept.” Calle Dao can appeal. We do appreciate the efforts of Erik and Speaker Johnson on our behalf. We are working with our friends from the Towers to rezone the block to prohibit sidewalk cafés—in line with most all of 23rd Street, east and west—given the increased foot traffic on our block due to development and the High Line.
