Our Assembly member, Dick Gottfried, is retiring at the end of this session after 52 years! His successor in our 75th Assembly District (Chelsea, Hell's Kitchen, Murray Hill, Midtown, and part of the Lincoln Center area) will be chosen through a Democratic primary on June 28 and a general election among all party nominees this fall. Tenants' rights, public safety, healthcare, parks, transportation, and education are all on the line.

JOCELYNE TORD (1934-2022)

Jocelyne Tord was a longtime resident of the 440 building, a board member of the LTTA since the early 1980s, and one of the key founders of the annual London Terrace Street Fair. Jocelyne was a retired teacher/principal for the NYC Department of Education in Chelsea. She was an avid folk dancer, swimmer, and world traveler. Among the many countries she toured were China, Egypt, Italy, Greece, and Thailand. In 2017, Public Advocate Tish James awarded her a commendation for her pioneering work on the LTTA Street Fair 25 years before, a community event that helps knit the people of the neighborhood together. She is deeply missed.

IMPORTANT TENANT ISSUES

RENT STABILIZATION LAWS RENEWED

The NYC Council just renewed the rent stabilization laws that were strengthened in Albany a few years ago. While the laws are surviving a well-funded challenge from landlords in the lower federal courts, no one knows what to expect from the current Supreme Court, which is overturning some longstanding precedents. (If the court were to take the case, it wouldn't be decided until June of 2023.)

We are also concerned about what our new mayor will do to raise rents at Rent Guidelines Board this June. (Mayor de Blasio held the line on rents more than any previous mayor.) The LTTA is making \$500 contributions to each of the three major tenant groups: Met Council on Housing, Tenants & Neighbors, and Tenants PAC, as we have in the past. We will keep you posted on how to get involved.

CURBSIDE COMPOSTING CANCELLED

We have been working together with the Department of Sanitation, Council Member Erik Bottcher's office, and our building's management to bring composting to London Terrace Gardens and the Towers.

We are sad to report that, after numerous meetings and all agreeing to participate, **Mayor Adams has canceled the funding for this program!**

TRASH SERVICE WILL BE IMPROVED

On a positive note: Council member Erik Bottcher and Department of Sanitation announced \$54,100 in increased funding for corner litter-basket service in Community Boards 2 and 4. The \$54,100 in additional funding comes from the City Council's NYC Cleanup Initiative, which will provide two additional eight-hour litter-basket truck routes, plus one additional 4-hour basket truck route per week.
